

# **UZH Teaching Fund (ULF) – Background and Aim**

#### Aim

The UZH Teaching Fund is an internal UZH funding instrument designed to support anyone involved in teaching at UZH in the realization of innovative teaching projects. It has been launched to support the realization of the initiative "Future of Teaching at UZH".

#### **UZH Curriculum**

The UZH curriculum defines university-wide quality standards for academic programs. Academic programs should be developed according to the following criteria:

- research-based
- goal-oriented
- engaging
- individualized
- transdisciplinary
- international



# **Overview of the ULF Funding Lines**





# open\_innovation - Focus on teaching innovation at course / module level

open_innovation	
Goal	Promotion of disruptive and experimental <b>teaching</b> innovations at module and course level
Special Aim 2024	Projects that are mindful of accessibility in the development and implementation of the project or its end product are especially welcome
Eligibility	UZH instructors
Duration	Maximum two years
Funding	Annual call for proposals for initial funding Maximum funding: CHF 50'000 Number of projects: 8–12 per year



# **Goals open\_innovation**




- Testing or further development of innovative teaching methods and concepts (course and module level).
- (Further) development of **teaching materials** that can be used in the long term.

- Projects designed merely to develop or refine content will not be funded.
- Teaching projects should exceed the basic mandate of each faculty/institute.
- Not all content criteria must be met, but the evaluation by the allocation committee is based on them.
- The projects adhere to the UZH Diversity and Sustainability Policy.

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
# **Application and Award Process (expected)**



## **Formal Criteria**



The combined employment level may not exceed 100%;
Justification why the requested funds are needed
Fixed sum for tutors, if needed



### **Equipment**

The amount spent on equipment must be reasonable and in line with the objectives of the project



#### **Finances**

Use of funding in a purposeful manner (max. CHF 50'000); Justification why additional funds are needed; UZH profit center



Fixed expense sum of 300 CHF; If higher expenses are requested, justification as to why these expenses contribute to the sustainability of the project is required







## **Content Criteria**



#### **Innovation**

- —Innovative teaching concept
- Learning objectives, learning activities, and assessments are closely aligned

#### **Effectiveness**

- —Projects are SMART
- —Appropriate cost/benefit ratio
- —Added value for students is evident
- —Projects take accessibility into account

### **Sustainability**

- —Provisions are made for (possible) continuation of courses
- —Innovative spirit of the project is not tied to a specific instructor, but is support by the department or faculty

### **Quality of Design/ Broad Impact**

- —Educational design is transferable to other courses and subjects
- —Insights gained are shared within and beyond the faculty
- —Planned project will benefit many students
- —Planned project provides a major benefit for large student cohorts

#### Student **Involvement**

—Students and their perspectives are included in the conception, planning and reflection of the teaching project

# **Application – the Most Important Aspects**

### **Teaching** Concept

It's the teaching concept that counts – not the content!



Proposal makes reference to the goals of the initiative »Future of Teaching»



### **Justification**

Demonstrate why financial support is needed to realize the project








